- Apply at 10 L/ha (soil) or 1 5 L/ha (foliar).

### **DIY Humate Liquid**

- · Mix 1 kg Humate Crystals per 5 L water.
- · Allow to dissolve. The crystals are highly soluble but heat and agitation will improve this process.
- Filter resulting liquid to remove any insoluble product.
- 10 15% is insoluble.
- Apply resulting liquid at 10 L/ha (soil) or 1 5 L/ha (foliar).
- Mix in sufficient water for easy application.

## Storage and handling:

· Keep dry.

# Precautions for liquid fertiliser blend:

- May stain foliage and fruit; avoid application close to harvest.
- · Not compatible with acid materials including all sulphate based trace elements, calcium nitrate and acid phosphates. Jar test if vou are unsure.
